1. GOD IS HOLY

- God made you.
- God loves you.
- God is perfect—

2. EVERYBODY HAS SINNED



Have you lied?

Been selfish?

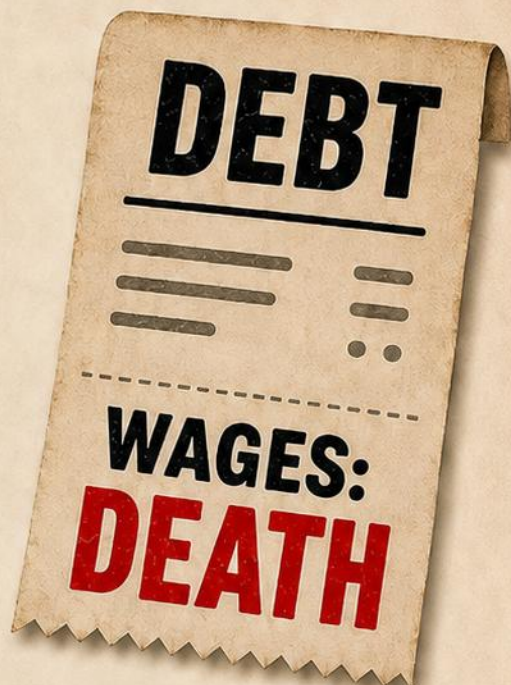
Everyone has sinned.

*For all have sinned and
fall short of the glory of God.*

Romans 3:23 (NIV)

3. SIN HAS A PRICE

- Sin earns a penalty.
- The wages of sin is death.
- We deserve separation from God.



"For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."

— Romans 6:23 (NIV) —

WE NEEDED SOMEONE TO SAVE US.

But God didn't leave us there.

4. JESUS

- God sent His Son, Jesus Christ.
- Jesus is God.
- Jesus became a man.
- Jesus lived a completely sinless life.
- Then Jesus took our place on the cross.



But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Romans 5:8 (NIV)

The punishment we deserved—
Jesus took. The debt we owed—
Jesus paid.

5. **PAID** IN FULL



- ✓ Jesus died for our sins.
- ✓ Then He rose from the dead.
- ✓ The empty tomb shows that Jesus conquered death.

DEATH:



JESUS: UNDEFEATED

**Jesus won. The tomb is empty.
The Gospel is true.**

6. SALVATION IS A GIFT

- You are not saved by being good.
- You are not saved by trying harder.
- You are not saved by religious works.

**You are saved by grace
through faith in Jesus.**

*For it is by grace you have been
saved, through faith—and this is
not from yourselves, it is the gift of
God—not by works, so that no one
can boast.*

Ephesians 2:8–9 (NIV)

**You don't earn a gift.
You receive it by trusting Jesus alone.**

7. CAN YOU REALLY KNOW?

YES.

**If you trust Jesus Christ alone
as your Savior, God gives you eternal life.**

*I write these things to you who believe
in the name of the Son of God so that
you may know that you have eternal life.*

1 John 5:13 (NIV)

**100% know.
WHO ARE YOU TRUSTING?**

*Believe in the Lord Jesus,
and you will be saved—
you and your household.*

Acts 16:31 (NIV)

8. TRUST JESUS

Trusting Jesus means relying on Him alone to save you—not on being good, saying the perfect words, or trying harder.

You can talk to God right now.

SAMPLE PRAYER (NOT MAGIC WORDS)

“Jesus, I know I am a sinner. I believe You died for my sins and rose again. I am trusting You alone to save me and give me eternal life. Thank You for loving me and saving me.”

These words don't save you—Jesus does.
Prayer is one way to express your trust in Him.
